Screening for sexually transmitted infections should be undertaken when there is:

- Disclosure of penetrative sexual abuse
- Physical signs of penetrative sexual abuse
- Consensual sexual activity
- Genito-urinary symptoms and history of sexual activity –e.g. penile discharge, genital warts, genital ulceration
